WORKSHOP

Paper Development Workshop (PDW): The workshop will be held in the morning of Monday the 4th of June 2018 in a round-table format. Only the authors of selected papers from the conference will be invited to participate in this workshop.

PhD symposium: provides a forum for PhD students to present their research ideas, and interact with and receive feedback from senior members of the research community, in academia and industry. The submitted manuscripts should be at most five-pages long and should be single authored by the student. The manuscripts should contain the statement of the problem being addressed, an outline of the planned methodology, contributions made so far, and the work lying ahead. Students with accepted papers will be required to make a brief presentation, as well as prepare and present a poster during the poster presentation event of the main conference. Submission should be done through the following address: infod@ict4ad.cm.

ICT Innovation for Digital Society: Students are required to submit a project proposal. Selected projects will be presented to senior staff of the conference and will also get a chance to materialize their ideas by presenting them to representatives from various prominent companies who eagerly look for innovative ideas to create new products that could change the world using their vast resources. Project proposal should be submitted through the following address info@ict4ad.cm with the keywords **ICT4AD project proposal** in the email subject.

Industry Symposium: The Industry Technology Symposium is a workshop for businesses which implement information technology solutions or which are facing challenges using them in their activities. These include Internet service providers, Telecommunication companies, electronic payment intermediaries, e-commerce entities, government agencies, financial institutions and many other Data intensive organizations. The Workshop will include educational sessions, multiple networking opportunities to discuss technology issues with other industry professionals and with students who are the future IT managers.
